A Tier 1 Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is being developed by the Virginia Department of Transportation, the Federal Highway Administration and the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation to study potential multimodal improvements that will address existing and future transportation needs in the Interstate 66 corridor from U.S. Route 15 in Prince William County to Interstate 495 in Fairfax County.

The meetings are intended to gather additional public input to further define the transportation problems in the corridor and refine the purpose and need for the study. The preliminary purpose and need is based on input received at public meetings held last June, transit and traffic data from various sources and other information about the existing transportation network.
