



Catch Basin Best Management Practices

This map illustrates the Upper Potomac River Watershed, divided into four major subwatershed groups. The groups are color-coded and labeled in the legend:

- Upper Cub Run and Elklick Run** (Light Blue): Includes South Riding, Loudoun Co., Fairfax Co., and Westfields.
- Flatlick Branch** (Orange): Includes Chantilly, Greenbriar, and Fair Lakes.
