Walney Road Widening and Bridge Replacement

**From Westfield Boulevard (Route 6755) to Willard Road (Route 6215) and;
From Dallas Street (Route 745) to 250 feet north of Dallas Street
*Fairfax County, Virginia***

Objectives:

- Widen Walney Road from two to four lanes near Willard Road
- Replace and widen the 85-foot-long Walney Road bridge over Flatlick Branch.
- Walney Road will be widened to include five-foot bike lanes on both the north and southbound lanes, as well as a sidewalk on the west side and a shared-use path on the east side.

The Walney Road bridge was built in 1980 and is now functionally obsolete. The road carries more than 21,000 vehicles a day.

Walney Road Widening and Bridge Replacement Project Milestones

ROW Acquisition:	July 2014 through January 2015
Utility Relocation:	September 2014 through March 2015
Pardon Our Dust meeting:	December 1, 2014
Roadway Construction:	January 2015 through December 2015
Walney Road/Bridge Closure:	April 13, 2015 through Sept. 1, 2015
Project Completion:	December 2015

Walney Road Widening and Bridge Replacement Traffic Impacts

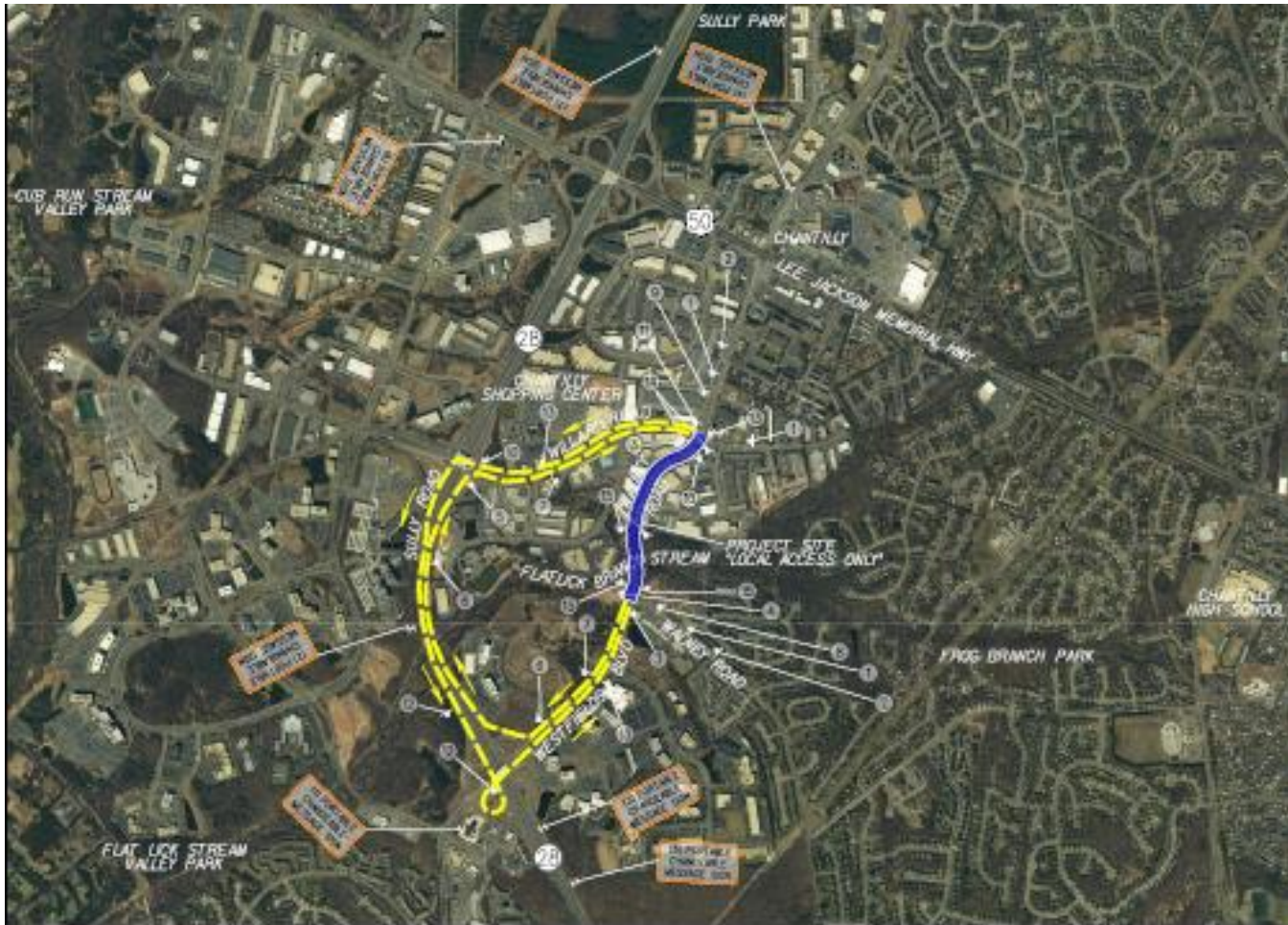
During construction, the bridge will be closed to traffic with a detour via Westfields Boulevard, Route 28 and Willard Road.

Walney Road will be closed from Westfields Blvd. to Mariah Court on April 13th, 2015 for relocation of existing sanitary sewer line and for bridge construction and will be open to one lane of vehicular traffic in each direction on September 1, 2015.

Access to all adjacent properties will be maintained throughout the duration of the project.

All private and commercial entrances within the project limits will remain open for the duration of the project.
