## SULLY WOODLANDS 2014 FACT SHEET



At 1,473 acres, the Ellick Preserve is the largest park of the Sully Woodlands core properties. This park is the location of state managed woodlands and is a prime example of a rare oak -hickory forest with diabase soils. Natural and cultural resource protection is recommended with a comprehensive trail network connecting the site to the other parks in the region.

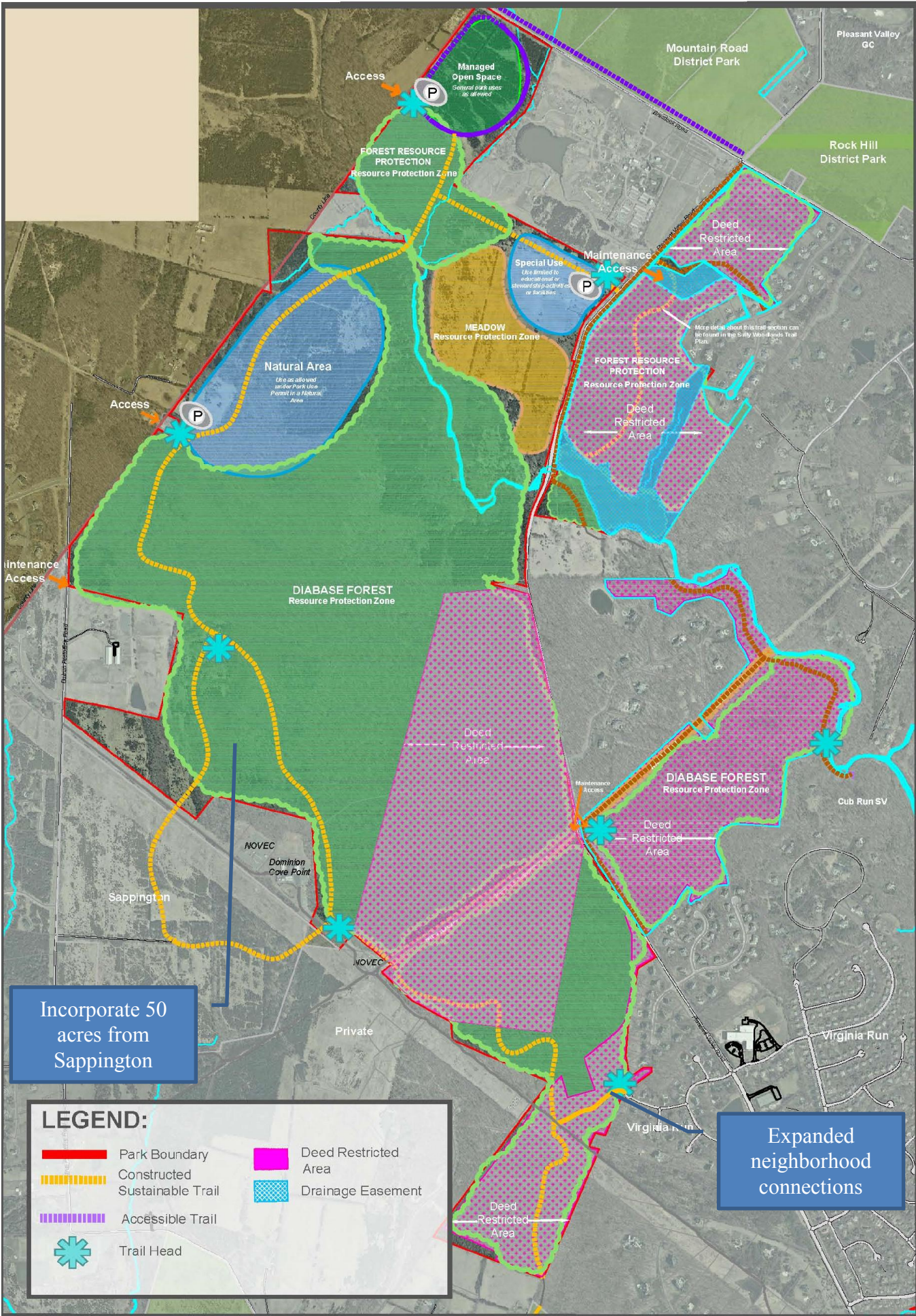


On the northern portion of the site a special use area is proposed for a stewardship education center or outdoor classroom.

A managed open space is recommended for the northern most portion of the site along Braddock Road.
