


At 1,473 acres, the Elklick Preserve is the largest park of the Sully Woodlands core properties. This park is the location of state managed woodlands and is a prime example of a rare oak -hickory forest with diabase soils. Natural and cultural resource protection is recommended with a comprehensive trail network connecting the site to the other parks in the region.

On the northern portion of the site a special use area is proposed for a stewardship education center or outdoor classroom.

A managed open space is recommended for the northern most portion of the site along Braddock Road.
